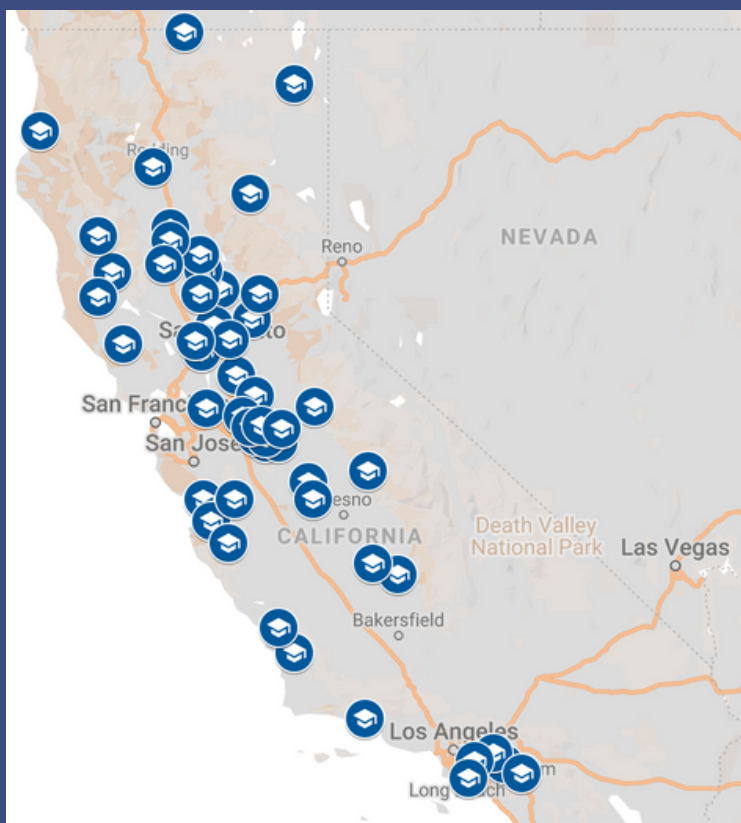

PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY

MENTORS:

- 5 or more years teaching
- Previous induction mentoring (preferred)
- Trained by CATIP
- Approved/hired on contract by credential candidate's school district

CREDENTIAL CANDIDATE (CC):

- Successful completion of an agriculture teacher preparation program
- Agriculture teachers entering their first or second year of teaching
- CCs with preliminary single subject: agriculture, agriculture specialist credentials, and/or designated subject (career technical education) credentials

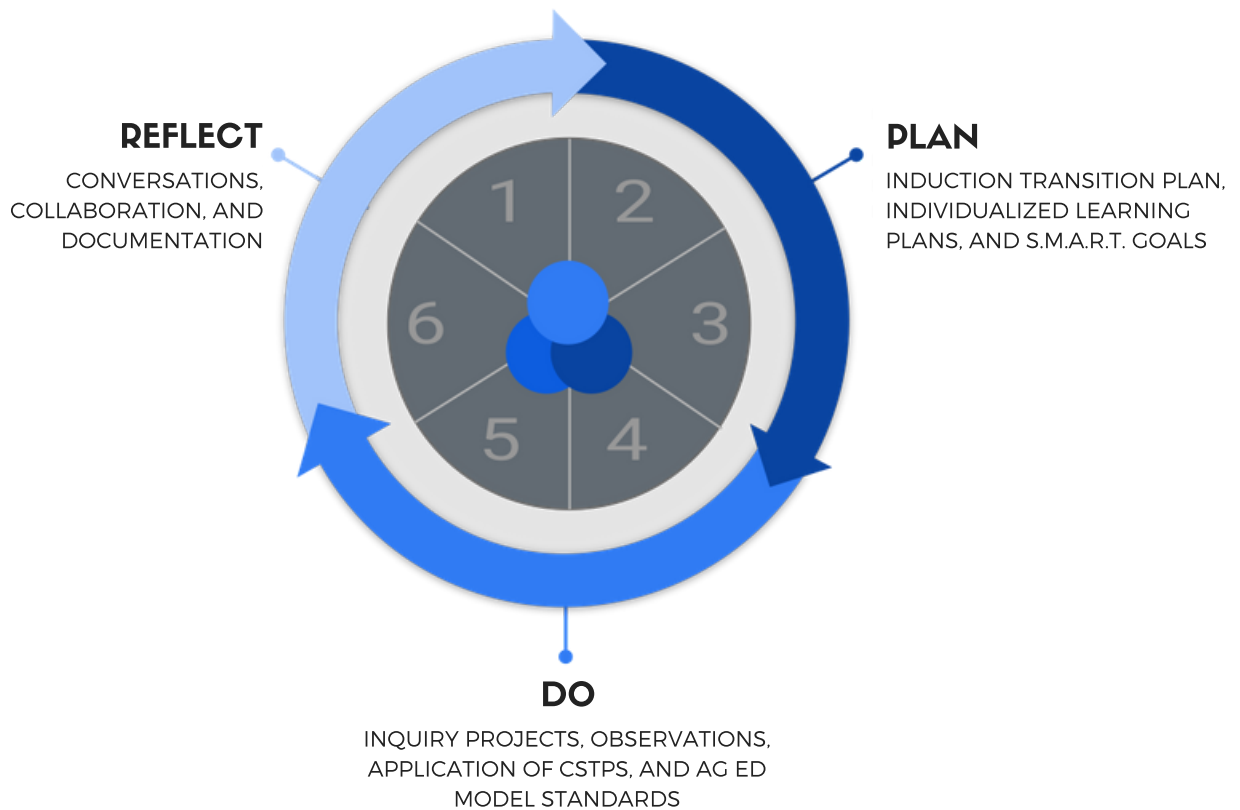

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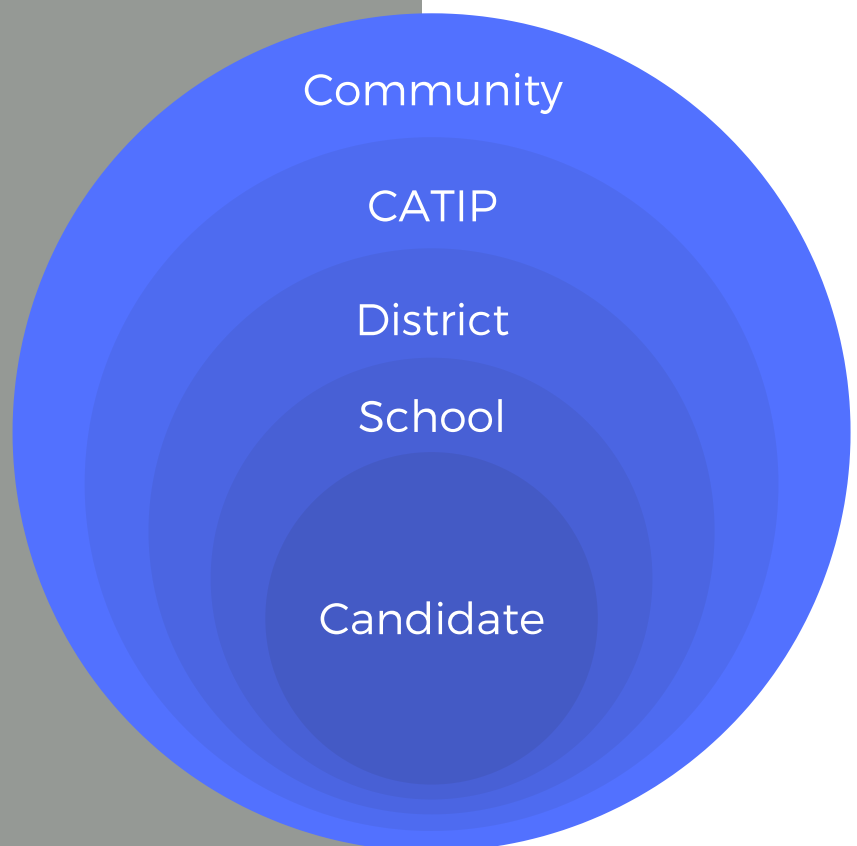
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PROGRAM MODEL

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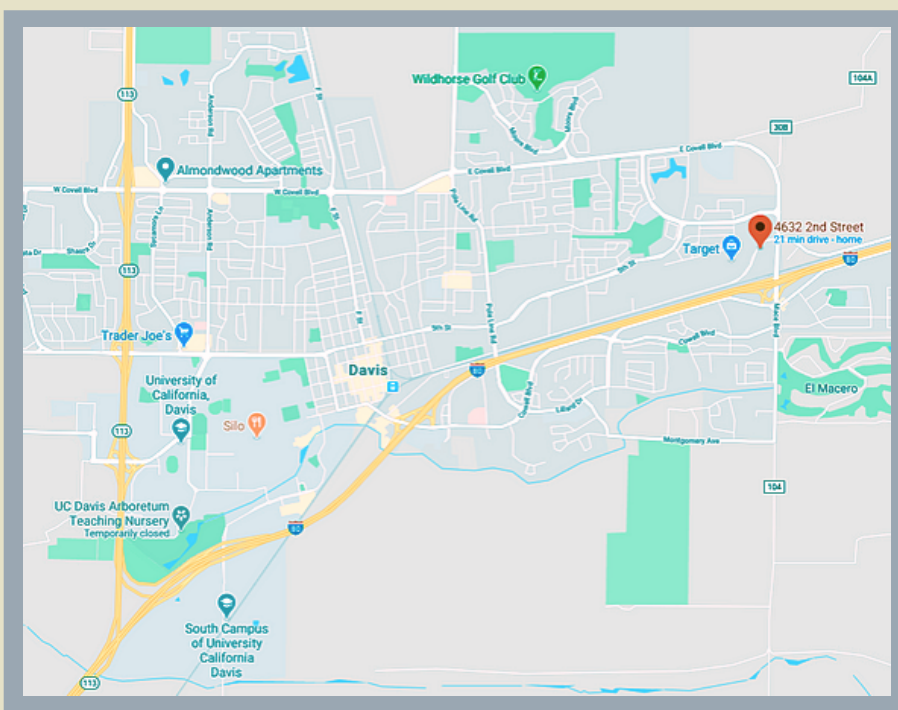
